

GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

In case of withdrawal of child from the school, parents must apply for Transfer certificate, with one week notice prior to the withdrawal. Any fees paid will not be refunded and all the dues have to be cleared before processing the Transfer Certificate. It will take two days for processing TC from the date of applying.

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION:

ASSESSMENT, EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

KINDERGARTEN SESSION: The assessment of child is done as per the cognitive skills, social and emotional approaches and motor developments as per kindergarten methods with works sheets.

STD I TO STD V - Students will be assessed by easy method of work sheets throughout the academic year as per the CBSE pattern of rating scale in the form of grades. III to V STD. will also be assessed through formative & summative assessment along with work sheet VIII.

STD VI to VIII - the syllabus is prescribed as per the CBSE Board's circular issued during the academic year 2017-18. Annual Examination marks are considered for the Promotion at the end of the year.

PROJECT WORK: Std VIII to X class students will have project work as per the requirement of the Karnataka State Board requirement twice a year in all the 6 subjects. General Knowledge, Value Education, Environmental Education, Physical Education, Computer Science, Art and Craft, Music activities will be graded during the regular classes.

NOTE:
